Not all items listed may in fact be discussed and other items not listed may also be brought up for discussion to the extent permitted by law. *Those submitting information at meetings are requested to send electronic copy to the committee chair prior to or immediately following the meeting for public posting.*

Please note that the time restriction was removed by Article 3 of the December 9, 2002 Special Town Meeting and approved by the Attorney General.

5. Temporary signs pertaining to a candidate or ballot question appearing on the ballot of an election duly called in the Town of North Andover shall require no sign permit and shall be allowed in all zoning districts. Such signs permitted by this Bylaw:
 - (a) shall only be permitted on private property;
 - (b) shall not exceed six (6) square feet in area per sign and shall not exceed in aggregate twenty-four (24) square feet in area per lot;
 - (c) shall not be higher than three (3) feet above ground level;

The following is the section of the Zoning Bylaw as it applies to political signs.
