


# Street Light Replacement Project Advisory

June 3, 2015

The much anticipated Street Light Replacement Project for High and Water Streets begins this week. The old, square tube, bronze poles and lights will be replaced with replicas of historical poles like the ones in the Old Center (see below). This will add better lighting and much improve the aesthetics of the area.



The work will take place through the months on June and July and will involve digging trenches in sidewalks and roadways to install conduit to supply the lights with power. Some sidewalk replacement is also included. Every effort will be made to insure that disruption will be minimal. There will be the occasional loss of parking spaces and some sections of sidewalk along the street but these will be very temporary (a day or two) and few in nature.

The first phase will begin at Prescott and High Street and work to the intersection of High with Water; the second phase will be along Water Street. The Town Engineer, Gene Willis, will be overseeing the project.
