Article: Election of Planning Board Members

To amend Chapter 6 of the Town Charter, more specifically Section 1 of the General Provisions of that chapter, (6-1-1) so as to include The Planning Board to the list of officers and boards to be elected by vote of the town

The Planning Board shall consist of five members and shall be elected at large for three-year overlapping terms.

The purpose of this article is to allow the Planning Board to be elected by vote of the town, thereby promoting greater citizen participation and transparency in decision making processes that are important to the town's future growth and development.

An elected Planning Board is consistent with the majority of towns within the Commonwealth that have the same Town Meeting form of government as North Andover, where 70% of such communities elect their planning boards according to the Massachusetts Municipal Association.

Electing the Planning Board shall ensure the interests of the town and its citizens are fairly and objectively represented and in keeping with governance by its citizens and for its citizens.

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To amend Section 16.2 of the Town of North Andover Zoning Bylaws by inserting the following language: "Drive-thru restaurants shall be permitted within the CDD1 zone provided they are located more than 250 feet from the R6 zoned district."

The purpose of this article is to promote the town's stated public policy goal of increasing North Andover's commercial tax base along Route 114 by encouraging the highest and best use of those properties pursuant to Massachusetts General Law.

This commercial revenue will benefit the schools, police, fire, and public works departments of the Town without increasing residential property taxes.
